\_\_\_ Though the general resurrections are at the end of time and the end of the 1000 years of Revelation 20, Jesus reminds Martha that He is the resurrection and the life. Meaning that He has the power to resurrect whomever He wishes, whenever He wishes.

\_\_\_ Jesus teaches that at the end of time He will send His angels to gather the newly resurrected saved from wherever they are to the clouds bearing Him and His angels.

\_\_\_ Those who choose to serve and remain true to God will be resurrected to eternal life in the first resurrection at the second coming of Jesus, the rest of mankind, everyone else who ever lived that choose not to be saved, will be resurrected in the second resurrection at the end of the 1000 years.

\_\_\_ At the resurrection we will be transformed from sin-natured, sin-weakened, mortal humans to glorified saints with perfect bodies and sin-less natures.

\_\_\_ All humans that have ever lived will be resurrected and be rewarded at that time with either eternal life or condemnation. All will have had the opportunity to believe in God and be redeemed
